

Lake Nakuru National Park: Rhinos, Predators, and Waterfalls

Overview

Experience the "Pink Heart of the Rift Valley." Lake Nakuru National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage site renowned for its stunning flocks of flamingos and as one of Kenya's most successful sanctuaries for both Black and White Rhinos. From the expansive soda lake to the hidden Makalia Falls, this park offers high-density wildlife viewing—including the endangered Rothschild's giraffe, lions, and leopards—all within a scenic three-hour drive from Nairobi.

Itinerary

- 05:00 AM | Departure from Nairobi Our

Ever Ready Game Rangers will pick you up from your hotel or residence to begin the journey northwest through the scenic Great Rift Valley.

- **08:30 AM | Arrival & Morning Game Drive** Enter the park for an immersive drive through the acacia woodlands. This is the best time to track the park's famous rhinos and search for leopards and lions before the day warms up.
- **11:00 AM | Visit to Makalia Falls** A drive to the southern end of the park brings us to the beautiful **Makalia Falls**. Enjoy a brief guided walk to the base of the waterfall, a serene and picturesque spot perfect for a stretch and some unique landscape photography.
- **12:00 PM | Premium Lunch at Lake**

Nakuru Lodge Enjoy a high-quality buffet lunch at the historic **Lake Nakuru Lodge**. Relax in the beautiful gardens and take in the tranquil atmosphere of the park from the heart of the wilderness.

- **01:15 PM | Final Shoreline Exploration**
A final sweep along the lake's edge to view the vast congregations of flamingos, pelicans, and the endangered Rothschild's giraffes that frequent the area.
- **02:00 PM | Departure from the Park** We exit the park and begin our return journey to Nairobi.
- **05:30 PM | Arrival in Nairobi** Drop-off at your hotel or residence, concluding your day of adventure with **African**

Bush Explorers.
