# Itinerary

Experience the breathtaking beauty and vital conservation efforts of the Ol Pejeta Conservancy. This full-day excursion is designed to get you up close with the "Big Five," the world's last Northern White Rhinos, and the country's only chimpanzee sanctuary.

## Itinerary Highlights

- 05:00 AM – Early Morning

**Departure** Our professional guide will pick you up from your Nairobi hotel in a customized safari vehicle. Departing early ensures we beat the city traffic and reach the conservancy in time for prime wildlife viewing.

- **10:00 AM – Arrival & Morning Game Drive** Enter the plains of Ol Pejeta. Keep your cameras ready for sightings of lions, elephants,

and the critically endangered black rhinos that thrive in this protected sanctuary.

- **11:30 AM – Sweetwaters Chimpanzee Sanctuary Visit**  
the only place in Kenya where you can see rescued chimpanzees. This sanctuary provides a lifelong refuge for chimps rescued from the black market, and you'll learn about the incredible rehabilitation work done here.

- **01:00 PM – Lunch at Morani’s Restaurant Refuel with a delicious lunch at Morani’s Restaurant. Enjoy a variety of fresh, locally sourced dishes in an open-air setting, offering a perfect moment to relax and soak in the bush atmosphere.**
- **02:15 PM – Meet the Last Northern White Rhinos & Baraka A truly once-in-a-lifetime experience. We visit the Endangered Species**

Enclosure to see **Najin and Fatu**, the last two Northern White Rhinos on the planet. We will also stop to meet **Baraka**, the famous blind black rhino, and learn about the intensive 24/7 security required to keep these species safe.

- **03:00 PM – Departure from Ol Pejeta** We begin our journey back toward Nairobi. As we exit the conservancy, keep an eye out for any last

wildlife sightings along the way.

- **07:30 PM – Hotel Drop-off**  
Arrive back at your Nairobi hotel after an unforgettable day of adventure and discovery.
